### Compensation/Credit

Applicant is responsible for arranging to receive credit through his/her school. This position is unpaid. Stipend will be available for transportation and lunch.

### Hours

We need an intern to commit to working at the LEV office at 3 days a week, for at least 4 hours. We also require that you attend certain events on the weeknights and weekends. While we suggest these time constraints, we are flexible and willing to work with people depending on class schedules/ job commitments.
