

Political Science Minor Requirements

- To apply, students must have a declared major, a minimum of 45 credits overall (sophomore standing), and a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- To declare the minor contact your major adviser and fill out the “change of minor” form with them.
- Pol S advisers are available to answer any questions about requirements for the minor.
- A minimum of 15 POL S credits used for the minor must be taken at UW-Seattle.
