WHAT IS NEW LEADERSHIP?

NEW Leadership is a national bi-partisan program developed by the Center for American Women and Politics at Rutgers University to **address the underrepresentation of women in American politics.**

The **six-day summer institute** educates college women about the important role that politics plays in their lives and encourages them to become effective leaders in the civic and political arena.

Participants are undergraduate and graduate women representing a wide range of socioeconomic, ethnic, racial, and educational backgrounds, and academic majors. Although the Institute's **focus is political participation**, the curriculum is designed to encourage non-traditional college students and students majoring in fields outside of political science to **engage in civic leadership.**

THE SUMMER INSTITUTE

The Alene Moris NEW Leadership Institute brings together college women from across the political spectrum to discuss the roles of women in leadership and politics. The program exposes participants to new ideas and opportunities as they consider their future careers.

During the Institute, you will—

- Learn from local women leaders who are actively engaged in the political and civic sectors
- Develop your leadership skills through workshops
- Become a part of a growing network of women leaders

The NEW Leadership Institute provides **valuable training** in all areas of leadership. Students learn their leadership style, how to effectively communicate with others, public speaking skills, negotiation, and many other skills.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

The Institute is open to **undergraduate and graduate women** who are either attending a higher education institution in Washington State or attending a higher education institution elsewhere but retain Washington State residency.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The only cost to students who are accepted for admission is a \$150 non-refundable registration fee. The entire Institute, including food, parking, and all program materials, is provided at no cost to participants. A limited number of scholarships are available to help cover the cost of registration.
