
Study Abroad in León, Spain

UW Program in León



During Spring Quarter, the Department of Spanish and Portuguese Studies takes a group of motivated students to the city of León, Spain, to live with local families and study Spanish language at the University of León.

León is a cosmopolitan city of 137,000, located in the Northwestern part of Spain. It is known for its 13th century Gothic Cathedral and monumental buildings, as well as for its fiestas. Every year people from all over the world visit León to see and participate in its many processions and colorful traditions.

Students will participate in group excursions and activities. Access will be provided to University of León sports facilities, library, and computer labs.

Participants will be placed individually with local families within walking distance of the UW Study Center. Three meals per day will be provided. This housing arrangement allows students to be immersed in the local culture and have the opportunity to speak only Spanish for the duration of the program.
